



# Little DOUBLE BLOSSOM CROCHET FLOWER

I crocheted the model in worsted-weight yarn using a size H (5mm) crochet hook.  
You can vary the size of the flower by varying the weight of the yarn and the size of the hook.

## Terms to Know:

ch = chain  
sc = single crochet  
sl st = slip stitch  
dc = double crochet  
tr = treble crochet

## Let's get started!

**Round 1:** Ch 2.

Work 5 sc in the 2nd ch from hook.

Join with sl st to first sc.

**Round 2:** (Ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2, sl st) in the same sc, sl st to the next sc.

Repeat 4 more times, making 5 petals.

**Round 3:** Ch 2.

Going behind the petals, sc around the post of the first sc on round 1, ch 3.

(Sc around the post of the next sc on round 1, ch 3) 4 times.

Join with sl st to beginning sc.

There are now 5 ch 3 spaces.

**Round 4:** (Sc, 4 tr, sc) in next ch 3 space and in each ch 3 space around.

Join with sl st to beginning sc.

Break yarn and pull through.
