# FLAS Fellowships

## FLAS Fellowships

The University of Florida Center for European Studies (CES) offers graduate and undergraduate Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) Fellowships.

These fellowships are funded by the US Department of Education under Title VI of the Higher Education Act. Fellowships are awarded to students (who are US citizens or permanent residents) combining graduate or undergraduate work in an academic discipline with European area and related language studies. There are two types of Fellowships, Academic Year Awards and Summer Awards.

## Summer Awards\*

Requires the intensive study of a lesser-least commonly taught language related to modern Europe, in the US, or in Europe. To qualify for funding, programs must be a minimum of 6 weeks in length and include at least 140 hours of classroom instruction at the beginner and intermediate levels (120 hours at the advanced level).

## Academic Year Awards\*

Requires the study of a lesser-least commonly taught language at UF for two semesters. The language should be combined with area studies courses related to modern Europe. Students are expected to enroll for a full load of courses at UF for the duration of the academic year (12 credits per semester for graduates and 15 credits per semester for undergraduates).

### CES Languages include:

Czech	Hungarian
Italian	Modern Greek
Polish	Portuguese
Russian	Turkish

*Other lesser-least taught European languages can also be considered (e.g. Dutch)*

## Fellowship Award Amounts

### Academic Year Fellowships

**Graduate:** In-state tuition and fees for 12 credits  
Stipend: \$15,000

**Undergraduate:** Tuition and fees for 15 credits  
Stipend: \$5,000

### Summer Fellowships

**Graduate and Undergraduate:** Tuition and Fees up to \$5,000  
Stipend: \$2,500

Application deadline: usually ends in mid-February.
